Course Outline – Master Esthetics

Mandalyn Academy is pleased to be a nationally accredited school teaching Master Esthetics, where we can focus our training on one of the fastest growing industries in the world. Our Master Esthetics program offers the most comprehensive professional training in Esthetics and Laser Technology. We know that a balance between ‘Clinical’ and ‘Pampering’ training has given our graduates an edge in their career, and believe that one is as important as the other in this growing industry.

Course Description

Mandalyn Academy’s *Master Esthetics* course is a 1200 hour program in which students are educated and trained in the theory and the practical skills pertaining to Master Esthetics and Laser Technology. Esthetics is a branch of anatomical science that deals with the overall health and well-being of the skin. A Master Esthetician is a person devoted to, or professionally occupied with, the health and beauty of the skin.

Course Objectives

Mandalyn Academy believes that a solid educational foundation is the most important element of a successful career in the Esthetics industry. Therefore, our mission and educational objectives of our Master Esthetics program are:

- To educate and inspire students in a professional and positive environment, that promotes harmony, learning, and success.
- To maintain a program that is constantly updated so students will have complete knowledge to compete in the Esthetics industry.
- To teach students a balance of ‘pampering’ and ‘clinical’ esthetics skills so they will have an edge in their careers.
- To teach courtesy, consideration, and positive thinking as the foundation of a successful career.
- To prepare the student for successful entry level employment into the esthetics industry and to pass State examinations.

Enrollment Requirements

The requirements for enrollment into Mandalyn Academy’s Master Esthetic program are as follows:

- Provide proof of age with a Drivers license, Birth Certificate, or Passport
- Be at least 16 years of age
- Hold and provide evidence of a High School diploma or grade transcript, or a General Education diploma (G.E.D.)
 - Or pass the Ability-to-Benefit-compass exam. An exam which measures the applicant’s aptitude to successfully complete the program.
- Complete and deliver a Mandalyn Academy application with a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee.
- Interview with admissions
- Receive copy of School Catalog via hand, mail, fax, email, etcetera, with acknowledgement of such included in Enrollment Contract.
- Complete and sign enrollment schedule and Contract.

Length of Course

Master Esthetics is a 1200 hour course, which follows the requirements of Utah State laws. The time it takes to complete 1200 hours is based on the number of hours per week school is attended. A full time student can plan on completing the course in approximately 8 – 9 months, and a part time student may take up to approximately 18 months.

Class Starting Dates / Schedules

Classes at Mandalyn Academy begin the first Tuesday of every month. Deadline for enrollment is approximately the 20th of the month prior or until seats are filled.

A student may select a full time or a part time schedule.

Mandalyn Academy is willing to work with students and their schedules. All schedules must be approved and agreed to in the Mandalyn Academy Enrollment contract. SCHEDULE CHANGE: A student is allowed one (1) *schedule change* without charge. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each *schedule change* thereafter.

Holidays and School Closures 2009

Mandalyn Academy is closed on January 1, April 10& 11, July 4, November 26–28, and December 24–31, 2009. All students will be notified if the Academy is to be closed for any extenuating circumstance.

Course Format

Throughout the course, students follow a course outline of well-defined motivational lesson plans in the form of theory and practical education, which includes, but is not limited to, lecture, workbooks, question and answer, demonstration, observation, individualized instruction, receiving services, and extensive hands-on practice on fellow students, models, and then spa clients. Morning hours are spent in theory and practical (hands on) theory education, and afternoon hours and Saturdays are spent for gaining practical hands-on experience and hours as students interact with, and perform services on actual spa clients.

To help students build and develop their skills and knowledge on a rising scale, the course is broken into 2 levels; Orientation, and the Master Level. Each level has been developed to help build student confidence before moving on to more advanced theory and practical training.

- **Orientation** – Students begin their training and education in Orientation, where they will spend the first 4 weeks of their program. Students devote these hours to learning the basic theory and practical skills needed to move on to working with clinic floor clients, and to more advanced theory chapters. After the completion of the required training, testing, and evaluations, students will enter into the more advanced levels of training.
- **Master Level** – Students continue to build and expand their skills in advanced theory and practical learning. Morning hours are devoted to class time where theory and practical skills are developed. At this point in the program, students spend their afternoon and Saturday hours practicing their learned skills on models and clinic floor clients.

Grading System

Students are required to receive a 75% or higher Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) which is calculated by averaging Theory and Practical testing and evaluation scores.

100% - 90%	= Excellent
89% - 80%	= Good
79% - 75%	= Satisfactory
74% - below	= Unsatisfactory/Fail

Graduation Requirements

Students must complete the following graduation requirements:

- Complete 1200 hours of training
- Achieve a 75% or higher Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Achieve a 67% or higher average on attendance
- Pass final written and practical exams
- Fulfill all financial obligations to Mandalyn Academy.

A student fulfilling all Graduation Requirements will receive a Graduation Diploma and Verification of Hours from Mandalyn Academy.

Completion, Passing, and Placement Rates

Mandalyn Academy tracks and files annual reports on school completion rates, State licensing examination pass rates, and graduate placement rates. Reports are due in the month of November, for the previous year, and Mandalyn Academy is pleased that our outcome rates are as follows:

State Requirements of Licensure

The requirements of the state are as follows:

- Graduate from an esthetician school with at least 1200 hours.
- Pass a written theory exam. (there is an exam fee)
- Pass a practical exam (there is an exam fee)
- Make application and pay fee to the State of Utah Department of Professional Licensing.

(State fees for exams and licensing are applicable and payable to the State)

The Academy will assist students in registering for the Utah State Board Examinations, but does not guarantee passing of the examination. Costs related to the State Board Examination and State Licensure, are the responsibility of the student. A student may supply his/her own practical examination kit, or rent one from Mandalyn Academy for a fee of \$40.00.

Employment Opportunities and Assistance

Esthetics is one of the fastest growing industries in the world and job opportunities are abundant. As a Master Esthetician with 1200 hours of Mandalyn Academy training you will be qualified to work for spas, salons, doctor's offices, in cosmetic or esthetic equipment sales, as a cosmetic buyer, as a make-up artist, on your own, and much more.

The **compensation** a successful graduate may reasonably expect as a Master Esthetician varies based on location and skill. Based on the U.S. Department of Labor statistics, the average salary for an Esthetician is between \$7.32 - \$24.88 per hour or \$15,230.00 to \$51,750.00 annually. Most often an Esthetician or Master Esthetician is paid on a commission of 30% to 60% per service with a commission for sales. The average price of a facial is, per industry and public studies, \$100.00. Therefore, based on the average, Master Estheticians paid on commission, can average between, \$33,600 - \$100,000 per year. A Master Esthetician may reasonably expect to earn a good living, earn a supplementary second income, or may choose to just earn a little extra income on the side.

Mandalyn Academy offers **job placement assistance** by training our students in professionalism, dress and appearance, resume writing, interviewing and networking. With the assistance of our Director and instructors, and by job posting and networking, graduates are finding rewarding and successful employment. However, Mandalyn Academy cannot guarantee employment.

Physical Demands and Safety for the Profession

A Master Esthetician may spend long hours sitting, standing, bending, reaching and repeating the same motions. Any repeated activities can cause fatigue and pain in various parts of the body. Students will be instructed in "ergonomics", a growing science that supports these health issues.

As a Master Esthetician it is important to be knowledgeable with the safety requirements for the profession. Students will become familiar with industry safety risks and how to protect themselves by using infection control, sanitation and disinfection, blood spill procedure, first aid, chemical solution safety, electricity safety, and much more. Mandalyn Academy teaches and follows guidelines set up by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

Application to Mandalyn Academy

Please call for a tour of our academy and to meet with a member of our administration for a telephone or in-person interview. Prior to registration, an official application form must be completed and turned in with a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee. This will hold your position in the class of your choice.

Enrollment Contract

The Enrollment Contract fully outlines the obligation of Mandalyn Academy and the student. The student will have the opportunity to review, understand, and ask questions prior to signing the enrollment contract.

Student Handbook

Each student is required to receive and read the Student Handbook on the first day of school. The Student Handbook is a reference guide to school policies and procedures.

Transfer Students

Mandalyn Academy gladly accepts hours from other qualified Cosmetology and Esthetic schools. The following are requirements for the transfer of hours and enrollment:

- A certified transcript of hours and requirements previously completed at a licensed Esthetics institute, and/or Cosmetology school.
- And/or a Cosmetology or Esthetician license.
- Meet all standard entrance requirements.

Mandalyn Academy reserves the right to test a transfer student and accept or deny all or a portion of the hours the student is requesting to be transferred.

A student transferring cosmetology or Esthetic hours into Mandalyn Academy's Master Esthetic program is required to acknowledge in their enrollment contract that he/she has received training and experience that is comparable to the subjects and training provided within the number of hours being transferred into Mandalyn Academy's Master Esthetics program. Upon enrollment a student has looked over the programs Scope and Sequence and feels confident that he/she can complete all program requirements within their contracted hours based from their previous training. The student understands that it is their responsibility to stay in communication with, and seek guidance and advisement from their instructor, in order to fulfill all requirements and graduate by their Calculated Completion Date.

There is a transfer fee of \$3.75 for each hour being transferred. Tuition is calculated at a rate of \$9.58 per hour. Transfer fees are non-refundable.

Mandalyn Academy does not recruit students already attending other Esthetic schools

- Tuition and fees are due upon enrollment into Mandalyn Academy, but with written or verbal notification from a loan institution that a student has been approved for the tuition amount, Mandalyn Academy may allow the student to begin class with a tuition due date clearly stated in the Enrollment contract. Failure to make payment on the due date will result in suspension until payment is made or termination from the program.

- Student loans from outside loan institutions are available to those who qualify.
- Any promotional class discounts do not apply to a refund calculation if a student does not complete a program due to termination or voluntary withdrawal.

Additional Instructional Charges: Each student is allotted a three (3) week grace period upon reaching their Calculated Graduation Date. An additional instructional fee of \$12.00 will be charged for each additional hour beyond said 3 week grace period (Calculated Graduation Date plus 3 weeks). All charges are due and payable prior to receiving graduation diploma.

Administrative Fees that may occur

- **SUSPENSION:** A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for each *suspension* before returning to class.
- **SCHEDULE CHANGE:** A student is allowed one (1) *schedule change* without charge. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each *schedule change* thereafter.
- **LEAVE OF ABSENCE:** A student is allowed one *Leave of Absence* without charge. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each or *Leave of Absence Extension* and each *Leave of Absence* thereafter.

Non-Compete Policy

Mandalyn Academy does not recruit students already attending or admitted to another school offering a similar program of study.

Financial Obligations

Student hours, supplies and equipment will not be released until all financial obligations owed the Academy have been paid in full.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Mandalyn Academy has in place a Cancellation and Settlement (Refund) Policy. The policy applies to all terminations for any reason, by either party, including student decision, expulsion, program or course cancellation and school closure.

1. Any monies due a Mandalyn Academy applicant or student may be refunded within 45 days of official expulsion, cancellation or withdrawal. Official expulsion, cancellation or withdrawal shall occur in writing, and on the earlier of the dates that:
 - a. An applicant is not accepted by Mandalyn Academy. This applicant shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid with the exception of a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee.
 - b. A student cancels his/her contract and demands his/her money back in writing, within three business days of signing the enrollment contract and beginning their training. In this case all monies collected by Mandalyn Academy shall be refunded except a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee. This policy applies regardless whether or not the student has actually started training.
 - c. A student cancels his/her contract after three business days of signing his/her enrollment contract, but prior to entering classes. In this case he/she shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid to Mandalyn Academy less the non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 and the registration fee of \$100.00.
 - d. A student notifies Mandalyn Academy of his/her withdrawal;
 - e. A student on an approved leave of absence notifies the academy that he or she will not be returning. The date of withdrawal shall be the earlier of the date of expiration of the leave of absence or the date the student notifies the academy that he/she will not be returning; or
 - f. A student is expelled by Mandalyn Academy.

- g. In type b, c, d, or e, official cancellations or withdrawals, the cancellation date will be determined by the postmark on written notification, or the date said information is delivered in writing to Mandalyn Academy administrator/owner in person.
2. Any monies due a student who unofficially withdraws from Mandalyn Academy shall be refunded with 45 days of a determination by Mandalyn Academy that the student has withdrawn without notifying the academy. Formal termination is determined when a student fails to attend school for 30 consecutive days and no effort from the student has been shown to communicate mitigating circumstances. Unofficial withdrawals are monitored and determined by the academy at each monthly evaluation period.
 3. At times, situations of extenuating circumstances for either party may arise in regards to a student's individual situation and to the program cancellations and refund policies. When extenuating circumstances do arise, Mandalyn Academy shall record the extenuating circumstance, communicate with the student, and keep records of such communication. In such cases Mandalyn Academy has the right to exceed the time frames and the standards for refunds to the student found in the Cancellation and Settlement Policy.
 4. Books and equipment fees are non-refundable and non-returnable. Supplies and equipment will not be released until all financial obligations have been paid in full.
 5. Transfer fees are non-refundable.
 6. All fees, and costs not included in tuition, are identified in Mandalyn Academy's school catalog and on the enrollment contract.
 7. Program Cancellation or School Closure Policy: If Mandalyn Academy's Master Esthetician course is canceled subsequent to a student's enrollment, and before instruction in the program or course has begun, or if the academy closes permanently, the school will provide a full refund of all monies paid.
 8. If a student withdraws from school and cancels his/her enrollment contract after entering class, or otherwise leaves school either by choice or expulsion before their graduation date, Mandalyn Academy will be entitled to retain and/or collect a tuition amount calculated according to the following:

- a. Enrollment time is defined as the time elapsed between the student's actual start date and the date of student's official withdrawal, cancellation, or termination.
 - b. When situations of mitigating circumstances are in evidence, Mandalyn Academy, upon its sole discretion, has the right to exceed the above standards for refunds.
9. If a student withdraws or is expelled from Mandalyn Academy prior to completion a \$150.00 withdrawal/termination fee may be charged.
 10. A student has the right to appeal their refund calculation. To appeal a decision a student must submit all relevant facts and information in writing within ten (10) days of determination to the academy. A final determination may be made within thirty (30) days. All decisions are final.
 11. If a dispute arises regarding the Mandalyn Academy's refund policy, and the student or anyone acting on their behalf makes a claim against Mandalyn Academy, its agents, owners, officers, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on the academy's behalf, the student will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of them from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as a result of such claim, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

12. In the event that a student defaults on financial obligations to Mandalyn Academy, the student will be responsible to pay all reasonable attorney fees and costs of collection, including any commissions due to collection agency.

Leave of Absence

Situations may arise requiring a student to take a leave of absence from school. In such cases, the student may apply in writing for a leave of absence, which must be authorized and signed in advance by the administration of the academy.

A leave of absence is for a time period of no less than 14 calendar days and no more than 180 calendar days. An authorized leave of absence will extend the calculated completion date by the length of the leave of absence, and the student will return to school in the same status as the last day attended before the start of their leave of absence. A leave of absence may be extended but cannot exceed the 180 days limit. Holidays and school closure are counted as calendar days and are included in the Leave of Absence.

There will be no fee assessed for the first leave of absence, but an administrative fee of \$100.00 is due with each leave of absence after, and with each leave of absence extension.

If a student fails to return to school on the date scheduled on the authorized Leave of Absence form, they may be automatically terminated from Mandalyn Academy.

Non-Discrimination Policy

No person or persons, on the grounds of age, sex, race, color, religion, or ethnic origin will be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subject to discrimination under any of the programs at Mandalyn Academy.

Student Access to Records Policy

Though Mandalyn Academy does not receive funds under an applicable program from the U.S. Department of Education at this time, the academy does follow the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA).

Written consent is required from the student or guardian for release of records in response to each third party request unless otherwise required by law.

If a student would like to view their records an appointment is to be scheduled with Administration ahead of time. If a student would like to have their records released to an outside party, Mandalyn Academy administration must be notified in writing by the student or the guardian of a minor student, with authorization to do so. A signed ***Release of Student Information Form*** will be required at the time.

Scholarship and Grants

Mandalyn Academy does not offer government grants at this time. Scholarships may be awarded to students enrolled in high school. Speak to an admissions director for details.

Academy Location and Facility

Walk out the front doors of Mandalyn Academy and your view is of the beautiful Wasatch Mountains. With easy and close access to Interstate 15, you are just minutes away from BYU, UVU, and Salt Lake City. We are conveniently located next to Gold's Gym, student housing

(not associated with Mandalyn Academy), popular restaurants, and many sources for social activities.

Mandalyn Academy Skin and Body Care Institute is a beautiful, spa-like facility which gives our students a real sense of the spa and esthetics industry. Students will be learning in our two large classrooms set up with individual lockers, book cubbies, and the latest texts books, learning information, and equipment. Practical (hands on) training will take place on the clinic floor which includes six individual service/consultation rooms with top of the line equipment, implements, products, and techniques.

Student Appearance and Dress Code

Mandalyn Academy dress code is very important to the student image and the image of our academy. A sharp, well-dressed student body portrays professionalism, and has been proven to improve performance and attitudes of all whom it is required. Students are required to wear ‘spa uniform’ tops with black dress pants or capris, professional knee length shorts, enclosed flat shoes, and to keep a neat professional appearance. Please refer to the Mandalyn Academy Student Handbook for more details regarding Student Appearance and Dress Code.

Student and Family Discounts

Students who are enrolled in Mandalyn Academy will receive 75% off any personal services that are not being done during practical learning time. A student may receive a discount on product purchases; however, each product line will vary in the amount discounted. Immediate family members, who include a parent, guardian, grandparent, sibling, husband/wife, or son/daughter, of all students while enrolled in Mandalyn Academy, will receive 50% off all services, *not* including laser.

Attendance, Absenteeism and Tardiness

Mandalyn Academy measures and monitors a student’s attendance in clock hours. Each student is responsible to abide by the schedule agreed to in their enrollment contract. A student will be charged additional instructional charges for any hours that are not completed in the allotted time frame listed in his/her Enrollment Contract.

EACH EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED ABSENCE AND TARDY WILL AFFECT THE STUDENT’S ATTENDANCE PERCENTAGE. Please refer to the Mandalyn Academy Student Handbook for the entire Attendance Policy.

Satisfactory Progress

Satisfactory progress in attendance and academic work is a requirement for all students enrolled in Mandalyn Academy Skin & Body Care Institute. The satisfactory progress of a student is evaluated by an instructor before the 10th of the month following the student reaching the point of 300 scheduled hours, 600 scheduled hours, 900 scheduled hours, and 1200 scheduled hours. A student must meet the minimum requirement of a 75% cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) and a 67% cumulative attendance average to be considered making satisfactory progress. Students meeting minimum requirements at evaluation will be considered to be making satisfactory progress.

Advising and Counseling

Mandalyn Academy provides students with academic advising on a monthly basis or as needed. Mandalyn Academy is not qualified or authorized to provide professional counseling services but upon need, will provide a student with a list of counseling services available to them in the area.

Make up work

A student is responsible to make up any assignments or missed work within the allotted time frame.

Student Conduct

Students prefer to study in an environment in which serious or repeated violations of standard are not permitted. With that in mind, Mandalyn Academy has established rules and standards of conduct in which their students are required to obey. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and to take personal responsibility by being the best student and future Master Esthetician they can be. Please see the Mandalyn Academy Student Handbook for more details regarding student conduct.

Probation, Suspension, and Expulsion

If a student fails to meet minimum Satisfactory Progress requirements after two (2) probationary periods he or she will be terminated from the program.

A student, who commits an infraction, is subject to discipline, including but not limited to immediate suspension or expulsion.
